**1. TIM's – Traffic Incident Management Safety -4 hours PM**

This class will provide information from the National Traffic Safety Council and National Department of Transportation on recommended practices for emergency vehicle placement and rescue personnel safety while operating near moving motor vehicle traffic incidents.

**2. Fire Department Round-Table - 4 Hours AM**

This round-table session is for department officers. Discussion and sharing will take place regarding department struggles, areas of opportunity, and ideas.

**3. Pumper Operations and Tender shuttle – 8 hours**

This program will present a logical sequence of events that will acquaint the fire service professional with an organized effort to deliver large volumes of water for fire suppression in a rural setting. The discussion will be directed at the amount of water needed, availability, and how to deliver it. The afternoon session will be a practicum to set up and flow a targeted flow of 1000 gpm for one hour.

**4. Live Fire Exercise – 8 hours**

This 8 hour class will cover aspects of Positive Pressure Ventilation PPV and Positive Pressure Attack PPA. Class will follow NFPA 1403 standard for live burns, using a site built training building with only Class A burning materials. Students will need Full approved PPE and SCBA and spare bottle.

Class Limited to 25 students.
